### The Viking Line fleet



Viking Grace is the world's first large passenger ship that uses liquefied natural gas (LNG) as fuel. With the help of LNG, the ship's nitrogen exhausts and particles are decreased by 85% and greenhouse gases by 15%. The sulphur exhaust level will be practically zero.

Since April 2018 Viking Grace is the first large passenger ship worldwide to be equipped with a rotor sail for the utilisation of wind power. This will cut fuel consumption by 300 t and reduce emissions by up to 900 t annually.

The M/S Seagas was specially built for ship-to-ship refueling for Viking Grace and has already performed its 1000<sup>th</sup> refuelling in 2016. Seagas is the first vessel of its kind.





Our new energy-efficient vessel will be 222 metres in length and have a gross registered tonnage of about 63 000 tonnes.

Energy efficiency will be very important in planning and building the ship. Viking Line engages Scandinavian architects for the interior design.

The new vessel will provide a brand new passenger experience for our guests.



# Always a little more of ... Safety

















- ► We currently only accept a <u>limited number of passengers on board</u>. As a result, we ensure that social distances between all passengers can be maintained.
- ➤ We limit and control passenger flows in the terminals and during boarding and disembarking of the vessels.
- ► We have expanded and intensified cleaning procedures and provide hand sanitizer to all of our passengers.
- ▶ We provide regular reminders about maintaining social distances and about the importance of people washing their hands often and in the correct way.
- ▶ We limit the number of guests in restaurants and shops. It is possible to have take-away meals or order meals to cabins.
- ▶ The selection of activities on board will be adapted to the present situation. We have programmes for both adults and children, but unfortunately the ball pit will not be in operation for hygiene reasons. We offer spa treatments, but our sauna facilities are otherwise closed.
- ► Check-in counters, information desks and cash stations will be equipped with plexiglass screens.
- ▶ We recommend payment by card, to reduce the handling of cash.

### Safety on board

- ► On-board navigation and safety equipment meets the latest standards
- ► Fast rescue boats, self-righting life rafts and new evacuation systems
- All vessels are equipped with Voyage Data Recorder (VDR) systems
- Safety training and drills take place regularly on board Viking Line vessels


### Viking Line's ships

- Environmentally certified according to ISO 14001 international standards by the independent certification body
- ► All our ships use "green fuel"
- International fuel-saving programme, harnessing of energy from exhausts as well as re-using waste heat
- All vessels meet the stability standards of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS 90) and the Stockholm Agreement
- Land-based power supply used in harbours

90% of exports and 70 % of imports are transported by ship in Finland

### **Environment**

- Viking Line does not discharge ANY waste water into the Baltic Sea
- Waste heat from the vessel's engines is converted into clean electricity
- ▶ Recycled from our vessels in 2019:
  - > 391 tonnes of glass
  - > 108 tonnes of scrap metal
  - > 732 tonnes of paper and cardboard
  - 1200 tons of food waste this yielded
     90 000 m³ of biogas (equivalent to 102 000 liters of petrol)
- ▶ In a four-month pilot project in 2019, the food waste per passenger was reduced by 40 % (equivalent to 70 000 portions of food)
- Savings of 1200 tons of fuel by switching off motors and use shore power during stopover in four out of seven ports – corresponds to about 3800 tons CO<sub>2</sub> emissions or over 28 million kilometres of driving by car
- Reduction of fuel consumption in comparison of the years 2015 and 2019 on the routes
  - > Turku-Stockholm: 2%
  - > Helsinki-Stockholm: 9%
  - > Helsinki-Tallinn: 10 %
  - > Mariehamn-Kapellskär: 6%
  - > Stockholm-Mariehamn (cruises): 15%
- Viking Line has received several awards for its environmental commitment



### **Our Ships**

- ► 6.8 mill. passengers/year
- ► Since 1959 a total of:
  - > 213 mill. passengers
  - > 21 mill. cars and
  - > 4 mill. cargo units have been transported on our ships
- ▶ More than 130 000 cargo units/year
- M/S Viking Grace is the first LNG passenger ship world wide
- ► From a distance of 100 metres, the noise level of Viking Grace is at 50 decibels – equivalent to a fridge







