Viking Glory

**Viking Glory** – one of the most climate-smart passenger ships in the world and most modern passenger ship on the Baltic Sea

- ▶ Liquefied natural gas (LNG)
- ▶ Zero sulphur emissions and reduced carbon emissions
- ▶ Waste cold from LNG is being recovered and recycled
- ▶ Highly effective energy recycling system, air conditioning and lighting system
- ▶ Time and fuel saving propeller system



**M/S Seagas** (the first vessel of its kind) was specially built for ship-to-ship refueling for LNG vessels



Viking Grace

**Advanced in terms of environmental and climate protection: Viking Grace**

- ▶ Liquefied natural gas (LNG)
- ▶ Nitrogen exhausts and particles are decreased by 85 %
- ▶ Greenhouse gases are decreased by 15 %
- ▶ Zero sulphur emissions

# Facts & Figures



## Our Ships

- ▶ 6.8 mill. passengers/year
- ▶ Since 1959 a total of:
  - > 213 mill. passengers
  - > 21 mill. cars and
  - > 4 mill. cargo units have been transported on our ships
- ▶ More than 130 000 cargo units/year

## On Board

- ▶ Approx. 6 mill. cups of organic coffee are served on our vessels per year
- ▶ Viking Line wins Swedish Service Score award for fourth time
- ▶ Viking Grace and Viking Glory have a snow cave on board
- ▶ High advanced conference technology on board of Viking Grace and Viking Glory
- ▶ World's first only floating Victoria's Secret Beauty & Accessories shop on Viking Grace

## Safety on board

- ▶ On-board navigation and safety equipment meets the latest standards
- ▶ Fast rescue boats, self-righting life rafts and new evacuation systems
- ▶ All vessels are equipped with Voyage Data Recorder (VDR) systems
- ▶ Safety training and drills take place regularly on board Viking Line vessels
- ▶ All vessels meet the stability standards of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS 90) and the Stockholm Agreement

# Facts & Figures



## Verified

- ▶ Viking Line became the first shipping company in the world to be verified by the accredited classification society Det Norske Veritas Germanischer Lloyd (DNV GL) in accordance with its My Care methodology
- ▶ This verification, which covers all seven Viking Line vessels and operations in six terminals, affirms the company's capability to manage and prevent infection risks, including Covid-19



## Environment

- ▶ Environmentally certified according to ISO 14001 international standards by the independent certification body
- ▶ All our ships use "green fuel"
- ▶ International fuel-saving programme, harnessing of energy from exhausts as well as re-using waste heat
- ▶ Land-based power supply used in harbours
- ▶ Viking Line does not discharge ANY waste water into the Baltic Sea
- ▶ Waste heat from the vessel's engines is converted into clean electricity
- ▶ Recycled from our vessels in 2019:
  - > 391 tonnes of glass
  - > 108 tonnes of scrap metal
  - > 732 tonnes of paper and cardboard
  - > 1 200 tons of food waste – this yielded 90 000m<sup>3</sup> of biogas (equivalent to 102 000 liters of petrol)
- ▶ In a four-month pilot project in 2019, the food waste per passenger was reduced by 40 % (equivalent to 70 000 portions of food)
- ▶ Savings of 1 200 tons of fuel by switching off motors and use shore power during stopover in four out of seven ports – corresponds to about 3 800 tons CO<sub>2</sub> emissions or over 28 million kilometres of driving by car
- ▶ Reduction of fuel consumption in comparison of the years 2015 and 2019 on the routes
  - > Turku–Stockholm : - 2 %
  - > Helsinki–Stockholm: - 9 %
  - > Helsinki–Tallinn: - 10 %
  - > Mariehamn–Kapellskär: - 6 %
  - > Stockholm–Mariehamn (cruises): - 15 %

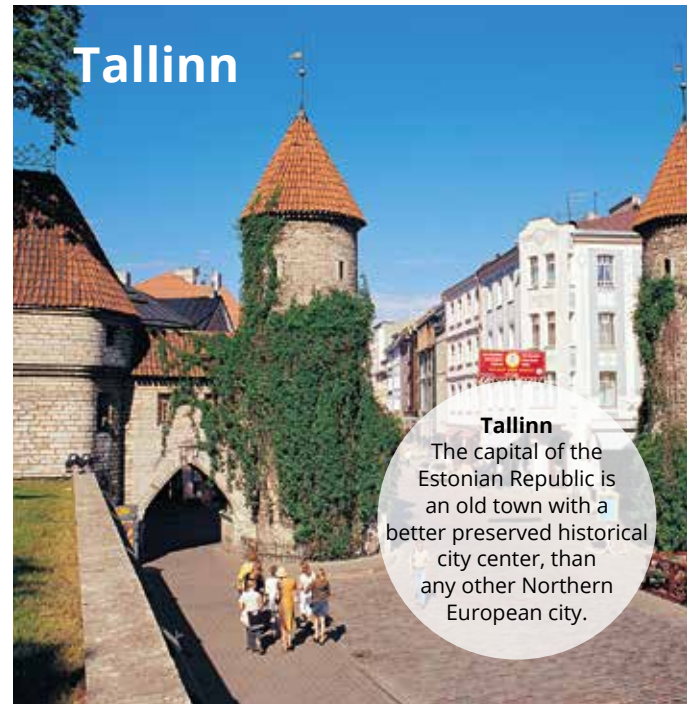

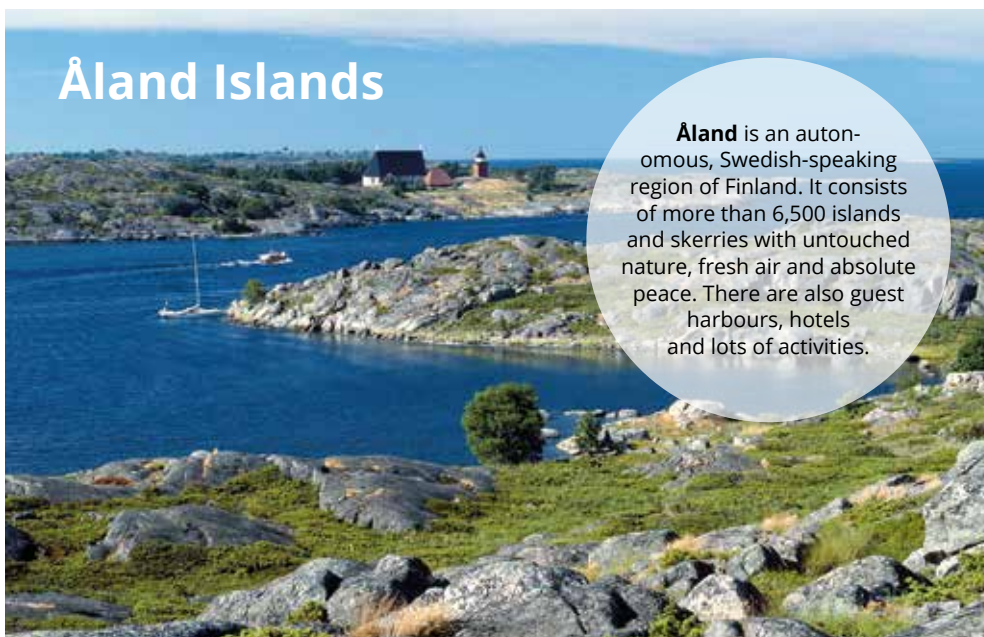
